

# Southern Africa Trekking

Visit the Kingdom of Swaziland and stay at a nature lover's paradise, Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary. Trek up the famous Execution Rock - the place where ancient Swazi Kings had "dealt" with their enemies. Enjoy an amazing view over the Ezulwini Valley (Valley of Heaven), visit local Swazi craft markets. Travel to the Kruger National Park in South Africa for 2 days walking in the company of a game ranger amongst the BIG 5!

# Lower East African Explorer

# Cape to Kruger Park

### Namibia & The Vic Falls in Zambia

View Southern Africa's amazing waterways teeming with animal, bird and aquatic life in the Okavango, Kwando and Zambezi Rivers. Cross the border into Zambia and travel to Livingstone and see one of the Natural Wonders of the World - The Victoria Falls.
